2015 Willamette Valley Rosé of Pinot Noir

A ticket to the Mediterranean. This dry Pink is perhaps more noteworthy for what it isn't: It's not drawn off any red ferment, nor is it any by-product, Frankenstein assembly or afterthought of some other wine-making project. Harvested earlier than our regular Pinot Noir, this wine shows the brighter acids, lower alcohols and the structural integrity of a purpose-built Rosé. The screw cap finish seals in the youthful vibrancy, fruit and acidity that makes this such a great wine for pairing with food.

Dry

12.8% alcohol

3.28 pH

7.2 grams/liter TA at bottling

Harvested September 12, 2015 from Bellpine Vineyards

Short cold soak followed by stainless steel fermentation

100% 115 clone Pinot Noir harvested a lower Brix for higher acids and lower alcohol

Not bled. No tricks.



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
