Pretty in the glass with a deep garnet color. Enticing aromas of toast and cherry welcome the palate to a lovely core of plum, blueberry and currant. A seductive juiciness is deeply underlain with a vibrant and savory array of mouthwatering acids and velvety tannins along with flashy barrel tones. Extended barrel time really pays off here with the kind of structure and balance that are the hallmarks of this exceptional vintage.
