



2016 Bellpine Vineyards Pinot Noir

Having risen from rags to riches, this brash, deeply controversial, frontierish and gangly red showcases a preternatural yet urbane savagery underlain with polarizing currents of heroism, acquisition, genocide, tariff and notes of old hickory.

A fading robardian back structure with hints of Calhoun delivers a panicky framework ensuring a systematic preservation of spoils while simultaneously avoiding nullification. In the mouth, lascivious tones of *affaire du petticoat* resolve recklessly into a temperamentally profane, uncultured and frequently volcanic finish.
