Gorgeous garnet in the glass with aromas of cherry and cherry pie. Deep French oak barrel tones in the mid-palate lead to darker cherry notes with echoes of cream.

Sexy, fine-grained tannins drive home a lingering and deeply satisfying finish of spice and camphor.
