Another gem from Bellpine Vineyards, this selection features three clones: Pommard, Wädenswil and Dijon 113. Anyone following the pedigree of special wine club exclusive Bellpine Vineyards Pinots knows that Pommard and Wädenswil are typically the true workhorses of this line. We love these clones and the love is not unrequited. Once in a while however, we can't resist a little Dijon clone in the blend. Here see how the 113 brings a welcome splash of darkness to a vintage otherwise tending red.

Jaunty aromatics of spice, briar and French oak pave the way to a juicy core of dark cherry and cola. Mouthy and viscous on the palate with toasty warmth and brambly textures. Sleek and mouthwatering on the way out with a soul-satisfying finish.
