

2018 Bellpine Vineyards Pinot Noir

Brilliant deep ruby in the glass.

This opens with a cocky aromatic profile showcasing plum, pomegranate, and blueberry fruits. Then a dry floral component emerges, beckoning toward a delirious bouquet of cedar/cigarbox, barrel spice, and a faint nuttiness.

Dark and blue fruits continue in the mouth bringing a hint of jam to the towering structure and balance of alcohol, tannin, and barrel spice. Bringing it all together this finishes with an unhurried layout of creamy oak spice and more blue fruits.
